The Effects of Dialogue Journals in Enhancing ESL Student ...

The first documented use of dialogue journals was in the 1980s with sixth grade students, both native and nonnative English speakers, in California (Peyton & Reed, 1990; Peyton & Staton, 1993). Many teachers, however, report having communicated with their adult learners through journal writing before this.

It is a low-cost writing-fluency activity that is relatively easy to initiate and can provide an important bridge to the adult, English-discourse community.
